South, 1919

"We had pierced the veneer of outside things... We had reached the naked soul of man." First edition in the original cloth binding of Shackleton's harrowing and extraordinary account of survival during his ill-fated Antarctic expedition. \$7000.

E. B. WHITE
Charlotte's Web, 1952

Of his much beloved children's classic, White wrote, "All that I hope to say in books, all that I ever hope to say, is that I love the world. I guess you can find that in there, if you dig around." A lovely first edition in the dust jacket. \$4200.

JOHN DONNE
Poems, 1669

"Come live with me, and be my love,/ And we will some new pleasures prove..." Important 17th-century edition of Donne's *Poems*, containing two of his more controversial poems for the first time. \$9000.

LEWIS CARROLL
Alice in Wonderland and Through the Looking Glass, 1866 and 1872

"I know who I WAS when I got up this morning, but I think I must have been changed several times since then." Exquisitely bound first editions of the immortal children's classic. \$23,000.

BE INSPIRED

CHARLES DICKENS
The Christmas Books, 1843-48

"It was always said of him, that he knew how to keep Christmas well, if any man alive possessed the knowledge. May that be truly said of us, and all of us!" A beautifully bound set of first editions of Dickens' Christmas books, including his immortal *Christmas Carol*. \$12,000.

JOHN STEINBECK
The Grapes of Wrath, 1939

"Then I'll be all aroun' in the dark. I'll be ever'where - wherever you look. Wherever they's a fight so hungry people can eat, I'll be there." First edition of Steinbeck's Pulitzer Prize-winning masterpiece. \$11,000.

HARPER LEE
To Kill a Mockingbird, 1960

"He gave us two soap dolls, a broken watch and chain, a pair of good-luck pennies, and our lives." First edition in the rare dust jacket of one of the great American novels. A most desirable copy. \$19,000.

WINSTON CHURCHILL
The Second World War, 1948-54

"I felt as if I were walking with destiny, and that all my past life had been but a preparation for this hour and for this trial... I thought I knew a good deal about it all, I was sure I should not fail." Six-volume set of first English editions of Churchill's brilliant history of the war, handsomely bound. \$3500.

ARTHUR CONAN DOYLE
Adventures and Memoirs of Sherlock Holmes, 1892 and 1894

"It has long been an axiom of mine that the little things are infinitely the most important." First editions in book form of these two collections of the famous Sherlock Holmes stories, in the original cloth bindings. \$17,000.

WILLIAM SHAKESPEARE
Poems, 1893

"For thy sweet love remember'd such wealth brings/ That then I scorn to change my state with kings." Beautiful copy of the exquisite 1893 Kelmscott Press edition of Shakespeare's *Poems*, one of only 500 copies, bound in the original vellum. \$8800.
